



HOMEROOM POLICY AND PROCEDURES

1. The homeroom is not a warm up room. Warming up should take place in your rehearsal room or performance venue.
2. Please leave the homeroom tidy. Another ensemble will most likely be using the room after you.
3. Each ensemble is assigned ONE homeroom key and only the person with the key can let you into the homeroom.
4. If the homeroom key is not returned prior to leaving, the ensemble will be charged \$75 to replace the key.
5. You may not extend the time that you are assigned to a homeroom. Chances are that another ensemble will be using the room after your scheduled time, sometimes immediately.
6. No food or drink (except water) allowed in the homerooms.
7. Cases may be left in homerooms during performances or behind stage.
8. Please do not leave the door open while the room is unattended. The Midwest Clinic and McCormick Place staffs are not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
