- A. Composition for High School. \$3,000 award. Maximum duration: 6'.
- B. Composition for Middle School \$2,000 award. Maximum duration: 4'

DETAILS:

- Composers must have been born on or after 01-7-1986 to be eligible.
- No compositions exceeding the maximum durations cited above will be considered.
- Compositions must not have been published or publicly performed.
- Women & minority composers are encouraged to enter.
- Composers must submit scores electronically.
- Synthesized recordings are permissible if no live recording is available.
- Winning compositions will be announced in December, 2020.
- Premieres will be awarded to 2 ensembles selected to perform at the 75th Anniversary of the Midwest Clinic. December, 2021.

Deadline for submission to the Midwest Office: September 1, 2020.
