




Sousa Sesquicentennial Statue Project

November 6, 2004 marked the 150th anniversary of the birth of John Philip Sousa. As a fitting tribute to an American Original the John Philip Sousa Foundation and the Marine Corps Heritage Foundation have jointly undertaken a project to raise the funds for the commissioning and erecting of a statue of Sousa. The proposed statue would be placed at the site of the new Marine Band facility in Washington, D.C. The cost of the statue is estimated to be approximately \$150,000. Noted artist Terry Jones has been commissioned to sculpt an historical likeness of Sousa in his Marine Band Uniform. The statue will be cast in bronze and will be approximately eleven feet tall including the base. Photos of the artist's model are displayed below.




