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







Tambourine

Tambourine Position: Head, shell, and jingles should speak together.









Third finger




Thumb

- 2. Triple bounce roll
- 3. Multiple bounce roll

Fast rhythmic passages from mf - fff








Timpani

Playing Positions:



Thin sound, too close to rim NOT DESIRABLE



Three inches from lip. Creates warm, rich sound MOST DESIRABLE








Triangle Playing and Roll Positions

Striking Positions:




Perpendicular strike
-Creates a single tone



45 degree angle strike
-Creates multiple overtones: Most
Desirable sound.

Rhythmic Passage Positions: pp - fff







Always produce an elegant and expressive sound on the triangle. Never a dry and abrasive tone.









Roll Positions: ppp - fff




Matched Grip Vertical

Correct Playing Position

Muffling:

- 1. Left hand on playing side of head
- 2. Right leg on playing side of head
- 3. Left hand and right leg on playing side of head
- 4. Left hand on opposite playing side and right leg on playing side
- 5. Towel attached to rim with triangle clip








Snare Drum Playing Positions




Xylophone Hand Position

Choking up on xylophone mallets will produce a thin sound. NOT DESIRABLE



Soft Playing mp - ppp




Holding the mallets in a regular grip position produces a rich, warm sound on ALL mallet instruments.




