## **HOMEROOM POLICY AND PROCEDURES**

- 1. The homeroom is not a warm up room. Warming up should take place in your rehearsal room or performance venue.
- 2. Please leave the homeroom tidy. Another ensemble will most likely be using the room after you.
- 3. Each ensemble is assigned ONE homeroom key and only the person with the key can let you into the homeroom.
- 4. If the homeroom key is not returned prior to leaving, the ensemble will be charged \$75 to replace the key.
- 5. You may not extend the time that you are assigned to a homeroom. Chances are that another ensemble will be using the room after your scheduled time, sometimes immediately.
- 6. No food or drink (except water) allowed in the homerooms.
- 7. Cases may be left in homerooms during performances or behind stage.
- 8. Please do not leave the door open while the room is unattended. The Midwest Clinic and McCormick Place staffs are not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
